- ❖ Attended Regional Congress party meet at Karimnagar in 1995.



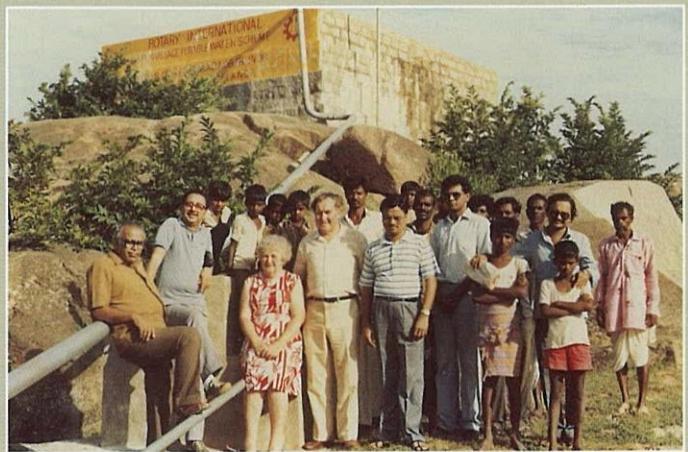

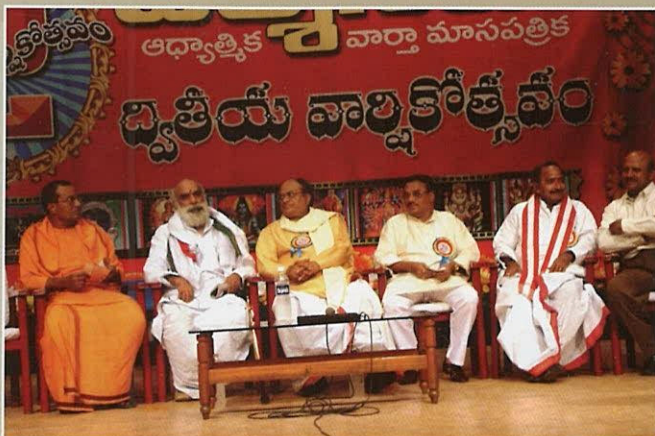

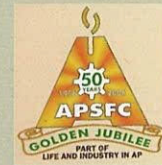
